4-year full-time graduation study for 9th grade primary school graduates The general mission of SOA is to educate and bring up graduates of economics and general and specialized subjects, primarily in the field of tourism in all age structures and to participate in lifelong learning by providing various forms of study.

The key mission of the school in the field of regional tourism management is to teach the graduate to create, promote, sell and manage the sale of various products and special tourism products. The school wants to prepare students well in the area of key competences, thanks to which the graduates will be ready to respond flexibly to the needs of the labor market, and at the same time their school should equip them with professional competencies that enable them immediately after school member of the employer team.

Basic pillars of Private Secondary School Pro scholaris:

- client access to pupils and parents based on open communication, mutual respect and partnership,
- selection of quality educators and their motivational evaluation,
- individual and human approach of teachers to pupils,
- emphasis on the development of pupils' communication skills in oral and written language in their mother tongue and foreign language,
- linking school with practice (animation activities, excursions, practice, projects),
- above-standard foreign language teaching,
- above-standard material and technical equipment,
- Guarantee of fixed amount of school fee during 4 years of study
- guarantee of clearly defined benefits for the pupil for paid school fee,
- remuneration of outstanding students (forgiveness of part of the school fee, valuable prizes for school representation and best class projects),
- ensuring a safe environment without crime, bullying and drugs.

The graduate should be prepared:

- communicate fluently in verbal and written communication, both in mother tongue and foreign language,
- manage all activities related to the establishment, planning of development, management of economic, financial, personnel, administrative and marketing activities of own or entrusted business entity,
- make use of the key and professional competences acquired in order to achieve professional success in accordance with the willfulness and character traits, such as responsibility for oneself and the work done, tolerance, purposefulness, empathy, openness and honesty,
- make use of the knowledge gained from the history, traditions, culture and natural circumstances of their country and European tourist destinations in the tourism

industry and proudly present their belonging to their family, residence, school, region, nation and their homeland,

- successfully continue studying at a university at home and abroad.

Graduate employment:

- independent organizer of festivals, conferences, presentation advertising events, sports and cultural events,
- independent organizer of group, family and individual tourism,
- independent entrepreneur in the area of providing catering and accommodation and supplementary tourism services,
- Coordinator of the offer of tourism services in the region in state and local authorities,
- travel agent offer and products, vendor, marketing worker, guide, travel agent delegate at home and abroad,
- informant, manager, organizer of tourist information offices and information centres events,
- informant, guide, manager and marketing worker in museums, galleries, castles, palaces, caves, national parks,
- organizer of tourism in regions and municipalities,
- employee of marketing departments, manager of activities in tourism centres (aquaparks, skiparks),
- manager in catering and accommodation businesses and facilities,
- separate travel guide,

School fee and its use:

The Department of Regional Tourism Management in Žilina was the first to introduce the Private SOŠ Pro scholaris. The number of accompanying events that pupils undergo during their studies, unlike other schools in our country, is not an inherently diversified teaching, but the pursuit of employers' requirement that pupils come into contact with practice as much as possible during their studies. At the same time, we have decided to set the financial parameters so that all pupils participate in such accompanying events, and not only those whose parents have sufficient funds. For these reasons, we have anchored in the agreement on the financial conditions of study in the field of regional tourism management:

- the school fee is set at a maximum of EUR 660.00 for the school year,
- the amount of the school fee is reduced depending on the achievement,
- the school fee can be paid without a single payment, in 2 or 4 installments, or monthly (maximum EUR 55.00),

- a change in the frequency of payment of the school fee is sufficient to notify the SOA in writing at any time during the study, we guarantee that the maximum fee will not change during 4 years of study,
- the school pays the pupil from the school fee:
 - accommodation, food and transport on four five-day courses of animation activities:
 - 1st year - skiing and snowboarding,
 - 2nd year - rafting of Orava and Váh on rafts,
 - 3rd year - horse riding and yachting course at Orava dam,
 - 4th year - course of alpine tourism and alpinism in the High Tatras,
 - accident and theft insurance for the entire study,
 - free access to the regularly updated internal school electronic database with textbooks, presentations, tests, etc., which is a supplementary tool to the textbooks that the pupil receives free of charge, as in any secondary school,
 - 50% discount on all language courses organized by the school in the afternoon for the public,
 - 10% discount on all language courses organized by the school in the afternoon for the public for the parent or sibling of the school pupil,
 - free preparation for the Travel Guide Certificate,
 - English lecturer in teaching English,
 - free wi-fi connection in all areas of the school,
 - standard equipment of the class - plastic windows, ceramic whiteboard with a marker, data projector resp. interactive whiteboard, notebook for teachers,
 - entitlement to free tutoring after class if necessary and interest of the pupil in the selected subject,
 - password-protected parent access to the child's online pupil book with grades updated every Friday.

When enrolling in the first year, the parent pays a one-time registration fee of € 100.00. The school does not levy any other fees (for aids, for a ZRPŠ, etc.) with the exception of the purchase of foreign language textbooks, which are workbooks. The parent decides on the child's participation in paid foreign excursions and foreign stays offered at their own discretion.

OTHER SCHOOL SPECIFICATIONS:

Project teaching

The specificity of the school is a separate subject of project preparation, in which the 1st and 2nd year students prepare an independent class project according to their choice of topic in any subject and present its final form at the school plea in May.

Pupils of the 3rd year draw the theme of the year project from selected professional topics and defend its final version in the practical part of the vocational component of the school-leaving examination. The aim of the project preparation is to teach pupils to solve the problem independently, to present the results of their work to the public in an impressive way. Defending class projects is public and parents like to participate. Current topics of year projects can be viewed in the section "News"

Teaching a foreign language

Two foreign languages are taught. Currently, English, German, Spanish and Russian are offered. Language school provides:

- 6-8 lessons of CJ weekly in the classroom (each student completes)
- project Tourism in English - 1 hour per week - conversation course focused on use in professional practice (each student completes)
- CJ courses in the afternoon for the public - 2 hours per week (pupil can choose)
- language certificates according to the offer of our partners (pupil can take the exam)
